

## British Longhair/British Shorthair standard 2017.09.30 FIFé

<b>General</b>	Size	Large to medium
<b>Head</b>	Shape	Round and massive with a broad skull
	Nose	Short, broad and straight with a slight intention. But not a stop as in the “Exotic”
	Chin	Strong
<b>Ears</b>	Shape	Small and slightly rounded at the tips <i>(Longhair) well-furnished on the inner side</i>
	Placement	Set wide apart
<b>Eyes</b>	Shape	Large, round, wide opened and set wide apart
	Color	Copper or deep orange, blue, odd-eyed, green or blue green, green is preferred
<b>Neck</b>		Head set on a short, very strong and well-developed neck.
<b>Body</b>	Structure	Muscular, cobby. Broad chest, shoulders and back strong and solid.
<b>Legs</b>		Short and strong
	Paws	Round and firm
<b>Tail</b>		Short and thick slightly rounded at the tip <i>(Longhair) well furnished</i>
<b>Coat</b>	Structure	Short and dense, not lying flat and with a good undercoat. Fine texture Texture should be crisp to touch. <i>(Longhair) semi long to long, standing away from the body. Short on the face, gradually increasing in length on the cheeks. Well-developed frill. Texture is firm, double, dense and plush with undercoat which gives the coat distinct Body. Seasonal changes in the coat density, length and texture are permitted.</i>
	Colour	Every hair should be uniform in colour down to the roots, except in tabby and silver varieties. <i>(Longhair) Allowance should be made in BLH kittens because the colour takes longer time to develop.</i> For colour varieties refers to the table below.

<b>Eye colour</b>	<b>A</b>	Deep blue
	<b>B</b>	Copper or deep orange
	<b>C</b>	Odd eyed: one eye deep blue, the other one copper or deep orange
	<b>D</b>	Green or blue green, green is preferred; outlined with the colour of tipping/pattern
	<b>E</b>	Green or yellowish green; preferably green
	<b>F</b>	Intense, deep Siamese blue
<b>Coat colour</b>	<b>G</b>	The Tipping/pattern of the hairs is dark
	<b>H</b>	In tipped cats, no distinction is made between shaded and shell cats; always apply EMS code 11 The back, flanks, head, ears and tail should be evenly tipped with the genetic colour. Uniform tipping is more important than the tipping length on each hair The legs may show tipping diminishing towards the feet. They must be free of tabby markings
	<b>I</b>	Cats with green and cats with copper/orange eye colour are judged in separate classes
<b>Remarks</b>	<b>J</b>	All eye colour varieties of Van/Harlequin are judge in the same class
	<b>K</b>	BLH/BSH w 61/67 are judged in the same class
